- Always close bag when items are not in use.

Installation

■ Step 1

After installing the QSBOLT bag on a compatible belt, tighten the cord lock the cord-lock to ensure no tools or loose items fall out.



■ Step 2

Secure cord by passing free end through d-ring at bottom edge of bag and back up to the snap hook at the top of the bag.



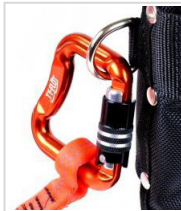
■ Step 3

Attach Quick-Switch® tethers can to the docks not to exceed the weight limit of each dock.



■ Step 4

Attach conventional tool tethers to side d-rings not to exceed the weight limit of each dock.
